

Fish out of water

Flying fish can leap out of the water and use their long, wing-like fins to glide above the water's surface for up to 50m. This can be extended to distances up to 400 m, using updrafts from waves. The longest recorded flying fish flight was 45 seconds off the coast of Japan! They use their flying skills to help them escape predators.

Can you help the flying fish fly through the maze and avoid any predators?
