

# KEY FISHERY SPECIES OF WESTERN AUSTRALIA

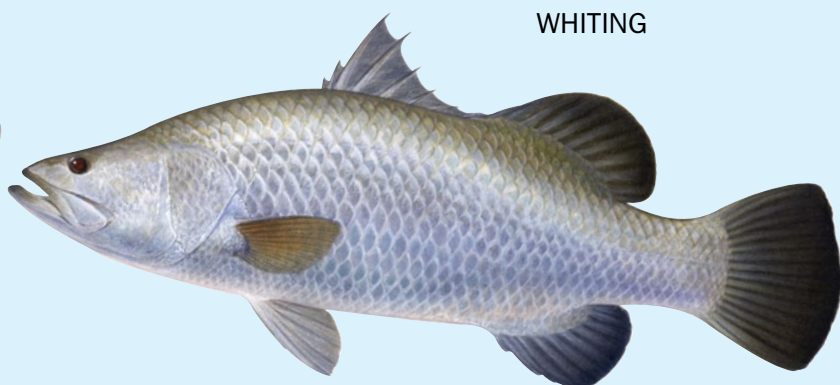
Western Australia's aquatic resources are important to our fishing, aquaculture and tourism industries and to many other aspects of life in our state.
