

### Preparing for your reef transect

Your upcoming excursion includes a field trip to study the marine environment in the Marmion Marine Park, just south of Mettams Pool. We will be completing a transect study on the reef platform.

Students will be wading in the water during these activities, and **it is the school's responsibility to ensure that supervisory staff with the appropriate qualifications are in attendance.**

Long pants, thongs or bare feet are NOT appropriate for this activity.

Attire suitable for completing this activity:

- bathers / board shorts - students will get wet!
- t-shirt / rashie / sun protective top
- reef walkers / booties / sneakers (students without appropriate footwear won't be able to participate)

You will also require:

- towel
- hat
- water bottle
- sunscreen
- complete spare change of clothes
- footwear for returning to school or continuing your excursion – please note if conducting an activity at the Hillarys facility following your reef transect, closed in footwear is required.
- GoPro and/or underwater camera (optional).

There are public toilets and showers on-site at Mettams Pool should you wish to allow your students to shower and change once they have completed the activity.
