There are many things that can impact on the fish's habitat, so it's important that we help look after it.

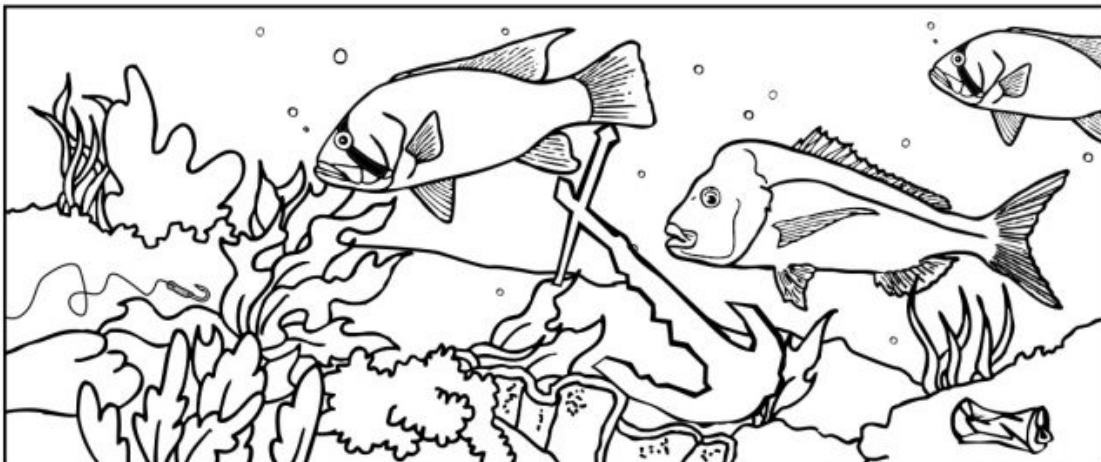
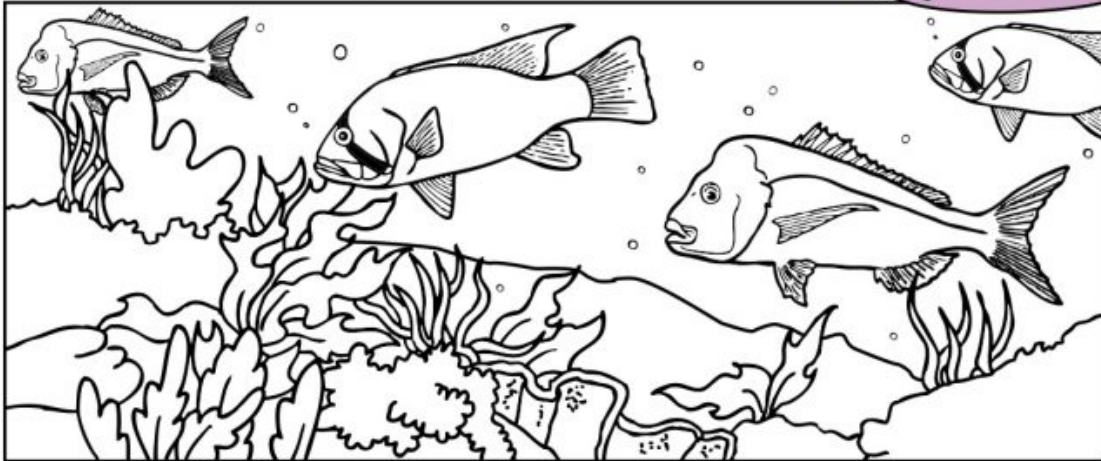
Here are some simple tips to help protect a fish's habitat:

- Always put your rubbish in the bin, or better still – recycle!
- When fishing, always put your discarded fishing line and bait in the bin.
- When out in a boat, drop anchor in a clear sand patch, to avoid damaging the seagrass and reefs.
- When walking through sand dunes or along a river, always use the paths provided.
