# Lesson: A day in the life of ...

## Phase of learning

## **Summary**

Students will choose an animal from the rock pool and write a description of a day in the life of that animal.

#### **Outcomes**

- Students will discuss the needs of animals inhabiting rock pools.
- Students will construct a short informative text about an organism inhabiting a rock pool.
- Students will demonstrate interaction skills.

#### **Duration**

30 - 45 minutes

## Preparation

This lesson may follow the Lesson: <u>Sharing a Shell</u>. It assumes students have some basic knowledge of animals that live in rock pools.

You may chose to complete this activity as a whole class discussion, or have students complete it in small groups or individually. Students completing the activity in small groups or individually may use Student Worksheet: A Day in the Life of ... as a template.

## **Steps**

- 1. As a class, brainstorm animals that might live in a rock pool. Discuss the challenges that animals living in rock pools face.
- 2. Ask students to choose an animal from the rock pool and write a description of the day in the life of that animal.

- You may choose to provide Student Worksheet: <u>A Day in the Life of ...</u> to students as a template; or for younger students, write the story as a class. Ask the students to dictate the story to you as you scribe it.
- 3. Students may include information such as:
  - What do I see?
  - What do I eat?
  - Where do I live?
  - Will another creature try to eat me?
  - What do I do when the tide is out?
