Fish has a lunate shape tail (like a crescent moon)	go to Step 2
Fish has any other tail shape	go to Step 5
Step 2	
Fish has a long and thin bill	Sailfish
Fish does not possess a long and thin bill	go to Step 3
Step 3	
Fish has a humped head and long dorsal fin (along length of body)	Mahi Mahi
Fish does not possess long dorsal fin (along length of body)	go to Step 4
Step 4	
Fish is predominantly red in colour	Yellowedge coronation trout
Fish exhibits counter-shading (dark upper, pale lower body)	Southern Bluefin tuna
Step 5	
Fish has a rounded tail shape	go to Step 6
Fish has any other tail shape	go to Step 10
Step 6	
Fish has eight dark vertical bands on the side of the body	Eightbar grouper
Fish does not possess dark vertical bands on the side of its body	go to Step 7
Step 7	
Fish has dark coloured face and horseshoe pattern on side of the body	Horseshoe leatherjacket
Fish has mottled or spotted pattern on the side of body	go to Step 8
Step 8	
Fish has flattened body shape (pancake-like)	Smalltooth flounder
Fish does not possess flattened body shape	go to Step 9
Step 9	
Fish has large oval shaped spots on side of body	Potato rockcod
Fish has small head and polka dot pattern on side of body	Barramundi cod
Step 10	
Fish has eel-like tail	Estuary cobbler
Fish has truncate tail shape	go to Step 11
Step 11	
Fish is predominantly green/blue in colour	Baldchin groper
Fish is predominantly red in colour	Mangrove Jack
